Back in 2011 the Centre opened its doors amidst much publicity, which put Caistor on the map, with the aim of creating a cultural community facility run by Caistor's people for its people. The Centre recently celebrated its 5th birthday, a milestone for any community charitable organisation, especially in these difficult financial times. We now attract over 20,000 visitors each year who come from around the world to visit our small town in the Lincolnshire Wolds.

In the last five years our volunteers have become the driving force behind the Centre and have achieved much more than was originally thought possible, but we now need your help to continue.

Our heritage displays, projects and events tell people how Caistor has evolved into the town it is today and tell the stories of real local people.

Our growing collection of historical objects donated by local people gives an insight into the past now and for future generations.

Local people have given their time to help in the Centre and in return we provide them with skills, support, social interaction and mentoring.

We bring twelve different art and heritage exhibitions to Caistor every year with accompanying talks, walks and workshops.
